

## Environmental requirement sheet for suppliers (version: 1)

- 1. The supplier is obliged to comply with all current environmental laws and regulations.
- 2. The supplier should take measures to minimise the adverse environmental impact of its activities throughout the product life cycle, from conception to utilisation.
- 3. The supplier is obliged to encourage its suppliers and subcontractors to develop and improve environmental programmes in their operations.
- 4. The supplier should promote and support the implementation of technologies that reduce greenhouse gas emissions, reduce the consumption of energy resources, and other environmentally friendly actions.
- 5. The supplier is obliged to reduce the consumption of raw materials and to minimise waste and pollution.
- 6. All materials and products supplied to Safilin sp. z o.o. must not contain substances prohibited in the supplier's country, the European Union, and the country into which the product manufactured by Safilin sp. z o.o. is finally delivered.
- 7. The supplier of any mixtures and substances is obliged to provide Safilin sp. z o.o. with a current safety data sheet in Polish, at the latest on the day of delivery, unless the safety data sheet has already been provided earlier and has not
- 8. When dealing with chemical substances or mixtures, the supplier is obliged to label the packaging in Polish in accordance with the applicable legislation.
- 9. The means of transport used by the supplier must be maintained in good technical condition, have an up-to-date inspection, and meet the emission standards prescribed for the vehicle.
- 10. If a supplier has not already done so, it should consider becoming certified to the requirements of ISO 14001, which Safilin sp. z o. o. encourages.
